### PACIFIC COAST ALES

**AWARD WINNING BEERS BREWED HERE!!**

#### **PCB Beer Sampler**

**Try all 7 of our house beers ...\$12.50**

**Pacific Coast Blue Whale Ale:** Either a IPA on steroids or a light Barleywine, this beer is definitely for the person who loves hops. The complex flavors are further enhanced with maturing over oak. Silver Medal winner at the GREAT AMERICAN BEER FESTIVAL IN 1989. 7% ABV, 86 IBU's on paper \$4.00/\$5.25

**Pacific Coast Bill Brand Memorial Porter:** Porters were some of Bill Brand's favorite beers. We've brewed one we're sure he'd have liked. Brewed with chocolate and Belgian malts, this beer is easy-drinking and lip-smacking good!. 6% ABV, 29 IBU \$3.75/\$5.00

**Pacific Coast Code Blue Barleywine:** Our Award winning Barleywine is back after a 2 year vacation! This beer is now pushing 10% alc. by volume. Malty, full-bodied, and warming. 2nd Place, Silver medal at the California State Fair's first Craft Brewing Competition, 2nd Place, Silver medal: Toronado Barleywine Festival AND Silver Medal at the 1998 GABF. Smooth as Silk. \$4.00/\$5.25

**Pacific Coast Elephant Seal Bitter ESB:** Amber ale, brewed with a malty character and balanced with just the right amount of hops. This ale is full bodied, but not too aggressive. Approximately 6% ABV. \$3.75/\$5.00

**Pacific Coast Gray Whale Ale:** Our house pale ale, medium body, amber, well balanced bitterness and sweetness. Bronze medal winner at the 1991 Great American Beer Festival. \$3.75/\$5.00

**Pacific Coast Cask Blue:** \$4.00/\$5.25

**Pacific Coast Leviathan Imperial Stout:** Black as Squid Ink! The Stout of Russian Czars! Brewed to withstand the long trip to Moscow from Great Britain. Black, full bodied and very warming. Silver Medal Winning Intense Ale at the 1992 and 1993 Great American Beer Festival. 10% ABV \$3.75/\$5.00

### **Guest Micro Brews**

**Anderson Valley Boont Amber:** Boont Amber is a medium-bodied pale ale with a beautiful copper color, a

robust head, and the rich flavor of caramel malt. \$4.00/\$5.25

**Bear Republic Five Zero:** Double IPA 7.7% ABV, 80 IBU. Celebrating 15 years of Bear Republic Brewing Co., this IPA is brewed from an old recipe (batch 50!) that is malty and very hoppy, just the way their Brewmaster likes it. \$4.00/\$5.50

**Bear Republic Racer 5 IPA:** This American IPA is a mouth full. It offers a twist from their regular IPA. It has different hops and is slightly sweeter. Hops, Hops, Hops!! \$4.00/\$5.25

**Brother David's Double Abbey Style Ale (Anderson Valley):** The dark brown color hints at the round malty flavors to come. Rich dark-chocolate creaminess mingles with semi-sweet malt flavors and the light scent of banana and fruit esters, while faint hop notes hide in the background. A full-bodied intense beer with 9% ABV. \$4.00/\$5.25

**Dempsey's Petaluma Strong Ale** is a local favorite. The pale malts, dry hopping, and higher alcohol content give this unfiltered beer a strong, complex flavor. Be careful, you might get hooked! 7.2% ABV. \$4.00/\$5.25

**Dogfish Head Brewing 90 Minute Imperial IPA:** Esquire Magazine calls 90 Minute IPA., "perhaps the best I.P.A. in America." An Imperial I.P.A. brewed to be savored from a sniffer. A big beer with a great malt backbone that stands up to the extreme hopping rate. 9% AVB, 90 IBU \$4.00/\$5.50

**Gordon Biersch Hefeweizen:** Gordon Biersch brews a true Bavarian Hefeweizen. The flavor has hints of clove, bubble gum and banana. True to the name and style, this Hefeweizen is unfiltered with the yeast still present. The body is crisp and effervescent. This beer is brewed with 55% malted wheat and 45% malted barley. 5.4% ABV \$4.00/\$5.25

**Lost Coast Great White Ale:** A crisp beer with a hint of citrus, made with two row malted barley, unmalted wheat, a secret blend of Humbolt herbs, crystal clear mountain water and ale yeast. 4.8% AVB. \$4.00/\$5.25

**Russian River Blind Pig IPA:** Blind Pig IPA was originally brewed by Vinnie at Blind Pig Brewing Co. in Temecula CA. Inspired by the original Blind Pig IPA, this beer is loaded with hop character but only has 6.0% ABV, 72 IBU. \$4.25/\$5.50

**Russian River Pliny the Elder:** From the brewery in Santa Rosa, comes this DOUBLE IPA. 8% ABV and 82 IBU's. Intense and Hopy! Defiantly for aficionados. \$4.25/\$5.75

**Sierra Nevada Celebration Ale (2009):** The long, cold nights of winter are a little brighter with Celebration Ale. Wonderfully robust and rich, Celebration Ale is dry-hopped for a lively, intense aroma. Brewed especially for the holidays, it is perfect for a festive gathering or for a quiet evening at home. Dry-hopped with cascade, centennial and chinook hops. 6.8% ABV \$4.00/\$5.25

**Trumer Pils:** Brewed by an Austrian Brewery in Berkeley, CA! This brew pours a bright gold color showing reasonable carbonation. Right from the start the impression is one of smoothness. A smooth mouthfeel, soft on the palate, a very mellow and delicate hop character matched to a pleasant pilsner malt flavor. \$3.75/\$5.00

### Imported Beers

**Lindeman's Framboise Lambic:** Classic Belgian Lambic Raspberry ale. Unlike American Fruit beers, this beer takes 2 years to make. It is fermented spontaneously and uses real fruit for its flavor. It is quite tart and is almost overpowering in its raspberry flavor. \$7.00

**Double Grimbergen:** Dark Abbey Ale, deep red, high carbonation, big head. Spicy nose. Pretty big and chewy. Hint of alcohol. Tasty...if you're not familiar with Belgian Abbey Ales, this is a good one to start with. \$4.00/\$6.00

**Monk's Cafe Sour Flemish Ale:** Brewed by Brouwerij Van Steenberge N.V. This is a very nice place to start your odyssey in Sour ales. Pours a nice ruby red color, with a gentle sourness up front followed with malty sweetness. Many folks taste sour cherry's. 5.5% ABV. \$4.50/\$6.00

**Stella Artois:** Brewed in Belgium, Stella Artois is a pilsner, it is "low fermented" at a low temperature to produce a delicate, hoppy beer, with a fine hop aroma and subtle bitterness. 5.2% ABV. \$4.00/\$5.50

### Ciders

**Wyder's Dry Draft Cider:** A dry, tart, sparkling hard Apple cider from Calgary, Alberta, Canada. Unlike the "cider" seen in the grocery store, this is approximately 6% alcohol. \$4.00/\$5.25
